2010 ART & CRAFT SHOW - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The President and Committee of TRATA advise the following conditions of entry:

1. Completed entry forms, together with fees, are to be received by The Art & Craft Show Committee **no later than Friday 19th March**.
2. All entries will be **accepted** at the Mechanics Hall **on Wednesday 31st March** between 10am and 4pm (no rail-freighted works accepted).
3. Exhibits must be **collected** between 4.00pm and 6.00pm on the final day of the show (Mon 5th April). **Entry form receipt or sales receipt must be shown for collection.**
4. Judging will commence at 10am on Thursday April 1st, but exhibitors are not able to attend the judging.
5. A fee of \$8 per exhibit must accompany the entry form and no more than three (3) works will be accepted from each entrant.
6. All paintings must be suitably framed with name and address, title and medium on the back of the painting with wire and screws for hanging or they will be rejected. **No painting will be accepted if over 100cm x 100cm externally; this will be strictly adhered to.**
7. All craft exhibits must be clearly marked or labeled with name and address of entrant, and materials used.
8. All works exhibited will be for sale to the public and TRATA will deduct 20% commission from all work sold.
9. TRATA reserves the right to reject any entry.
10. Exhibitors shall allow their work to be shown in Newspapers or on TV.
11. TRATA will exercise due care of all works submitted but will not be responsible for loss or damage of any work whilst in its custody. Insurance for works entered rests with the entrant.
